

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE providing for the establishment of certain traffic regulations in the Township of Pymatuning and providing for the installation of appropriate signs to give notice thereof.

BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation, whether principal or agent, to violate or fail to comply with the following regulations pertaining to traffic in the Township of Pymatuning, subject to the penalties hereinafter provided:

SECTION 2. That all motor or other vehicles shall stop in obedience to the stop signs now or hereafter placed at the following locations:

- (a) Southwest corner of the intersection of Third Street and "A" Street
- ✓ (b) Southwest corner of the intersection of Third Street and "B" Street
- (c) Northeast corner of the intersection of Third Street and "A" Street
- ✓ (d) Northeast corner of the intersection of Third Street and "B" Street
- (e) Northeast corner of intersection of Tenth Street and "A" Street
- (f) Northwest corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "A" Street
- (g) Southeast corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "A" Street
- ✓ (h) Southwest corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "A" Street
- (i) Northeast corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "B" Street
- ✓ (j) Northwest corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "B" Street
- ✓ (k) Southeast corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "B" Street
- (l) Southwest corner of the intersection of Tenth Street and "B" Street
- (m) West side of "A" Street at the intersection of "A" Street and "E" Street
- (n) West side of "B" Street at the intersection of "B" Street and "E" Street
- (o) East side of "A" Street at the intersection of "A" Street and "B" Street
- (p) West side of "A" Street at the intersection of "A" Street and "B" Street

SECTION 3. The proper officials of the Township are hereby directed to erect signs at all of the locations hereinabove designated.

SECTION 4. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace in the Township be fined not less than one (\$1.00) dollar nor more than ten (10.00) dollars, to be collected as fines and penalties are now collected, and in default of payment to undergo imprisonment in the

County Jail for a period not to exceed five (5) days.
