

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 2 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, which provides for the levy, and collection of a tax, for general revenue purposes, on admissions to amusements within the Township of Pymatuning.


BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2 of the Township of Pymatuning providing for the levy, assessment and collection of a tax on admissions to amusements within the Township of Pymatuning be and the same is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective on April 1, 1953.

SECTION 3. That the enactment of this Ordinance shall have no effect on the right of the Township to collect any unpaid taxes on admissions to amusements conducted in said Township prior to April 1, 1953.
