## ORDINANCE NO. 37

An Ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, creating and establishing a township planning commission.

Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That a township planning commission be and is hereby created in the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, to be known as "Pymatuning Township Planning Commission", pursuant to the authority contained in the Act of Assembly of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, art. XX-A, Section 2051; 53 P. S. Sec. 67051, as amended. Said commission shall consist of five members to be appointed by the Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning for terms of five years, except that the terms of the members first appointed shall be so fixed that one member shall be appointed for one year, one for two years, one for three years, one for four years, and one for five years, and annually thereafter a member of said commission shall be appointed for a term of five years.

SECTION 2. That the Pymatuning Township Planning Commission shall have and possess all the powers and duties granted by the Second Class Township Code.
