An Ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County,

Pennsylvania, vacating Township Road T-466 extending from Township Road

T-589 in a northerly direction, a distance of 875 feet, more or less, to Station

18+0 of the Relocation of Township Road T-466.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following Township Road in the Township of Pymatuning be and is hereby vacated and closed as a public highway of the Township of Pymatuning:

Township Road T-466 extending from Township Road T-589 in a northerly direction, a distance of 875 feet, more or less, to Station 18+0 of the Relocation of Township Road T-466.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is passed pursuant to a contract between the United States of America and the Township of Pymatuning by which the Township of Pymatuning agreed to vacate and extinguish its public easement in certain roads of the Township of Pymatuning as part of the development of the reservoir project known as Shenango Reservoir.

SECTION 3: That the Supervisors shall cause the plan or map of the highways or roads of the township to be corrected to show the vacation effected
