

AN ORDINANCE OF PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, amending Ordinance No. 65 of said township, entitled an "Ordinance of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, supplementing the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and further regulating sewage disposal systems in Pymatuning Township." requiring contractors engaged in the installation of sewage systems in the Township to file a surety bond with the Township, and making the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and regulations adopted thereunder applicable to lots of all sizes.

Be It Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Enacted and Ordained by and with the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 65 be amended to read as follows:

"The provisions of the Sewage Facilities Act as presently enacted, or subsequently amended, and all rules, regulations, standards and procedures adopted by the Department of Health of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania pursuant thereto shall apply to all individual sewage systems or community sewage systems hereafter constructed within Pymatuning Township including those that would otherwise be exempt under the provisions of the Sewage Facilities Act because of lot size."

Section 2. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 65 be amended by adding thereto the following sentence:

"Any contractor who undertakes to install one or more individual or community sewage systems in Pymatuning Township shall first file with the Township Secretary one bond in the amount of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars payable to the Township of Pymatuning with corporate surety satisfactory to the Township, conditioned for the faithful compliance by the contractor with the construction provisions of Ordinance No. 65, as well as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act and any amendments thereto."
