

ORDINANCE NO. 73

An ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, amending the ordinance currently in effect in the Township of Pymatuning entitled "An Ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, providing for the levy, assessment and collection of a per capita tax, for general revenue purposes, of \$5.00 on each and every resident and inhabitant of the Township of Pymatuning over twenty-one (21) years of age; conferring powers and imposing duties on the Tax Collector and prescribing discounts, penalties, and collection procedure" to provide that the tax levied under the existing ordinance be a permanent tax.

Be It Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: That Section 2 of the currently effective ordinance providing for the levy of a per capita tax of five (\$5.00) dollars per annum upon each resident of the Township of Pymatuning over twenty-one (21) years of age be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1: The tax levied by this ordinance shall be an annual tax and shall continue on a calendar year basis without annual reenactment.

Section 2: This ordinance is adopted under the authority of the Act of December 31, 1965, P.L. 1257, as amended, known as "The Local Tax Enabling Act"
