## ORDINANCE NO. 74

An Ordinance of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, vacating a portion of Brentwood Drive in Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property abutting a portion of Brentwood

Drive in Pymatuning Township have petitioned the Board of Supervisors of

Pymatuning Township to vacate that portion of Brentwood Drive on which their

lands abut, which portion of Brentwood Drive is hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Enacted and Ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. That the following portion of Brentwood Drive be and is hereby vacated as a public street:

Beginning at the northwesterly edge of the right-of-way of Second Street; thence northwesterly and northeasterly to the southwestern edge of the right-of-way of Fourth Street.

SECTION 2. That following the enactment of this ordinance, a certified copy of the ordinance, together with a draft or survey of the vacated portion of Brentwood Drive showing its location, and width, be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Mercer County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3. That the Township Secretary is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes and corrections on the plan or map of the roads of the township.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is enacted and ordained pursuant to the petition of all of the property owners abutting the above-mentioned portion of Brentwood Drive in accordance with the Act of May 1, 1933,
