ORDINANCE NO. 84

An Ordinance of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, providing for the grading, improvement with tar and chip road materials and necessary drainage of Pleasant View Drive, and providing for the assessment of a portion of the costs thereof against the owners of abutting properties.

BEIT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

- Section 1: That Pleasant View Drive, a public street of the township, be improved with the application of tar and chip road materials with necessary grading and drainage.
- Section 2: That the cost of said improvement, but not exceeding \$.25 per foot, shall be assessed against all properties abutting the line of the proposed improvement and shall be paid for by and collected from the owners of property abutting the line of said improvement in accordance with Section 1136 of the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. XI, as amended; 53 P. S. \$66136, authorizing the assessment of the cost of any such improvement against the owners of real estate abutting thereon, upon petition presented by the owners of property representing a majority in number of feet front of the properties abutting on the street to be improved. That portion of the cost not assessed shall be borne by the township.
- Section 3: That the township engineer is hereby designated as the person in charge of said work, and he is hereby directed to estimate all assessments with relation to said improvement, with the assessments to be based on the foot front rule but with the assessment against each property owner not to exceed \$.25 per foot.
- Section 4: That any trees, pipes or other materials interfering with free and full construction of said work are hereby declared to be nuisances and may be removed or changed by or under the direction of the township engineer.
 - That the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township are hereby authorized to prepare and procure full and complete specifications for said improvement and advertise for proposals or bids for the contract therefor, or if they see fit may do the work of any part thereof with the township's own force of men and equipment.
