

ORDINANCE NO. 86

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 28 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, which establishes certain traffic regulations in the Township of Pymatuning, restricting the travel of trucks on certain township roads except for the purpose of making local deliveries.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 28 be and is hereby amended by substituting for Section 3 of Ordinance No. 28 the following:

Section 3: Trucks are prohibited on the following roads of the township except for the purpose of making local deliveries:

Township Road No. 426, known as Wall Street
Township Road No. 432, known as Arlington Drive
Township Road No. 434, known as Brentwood Drive
Township Road No. 466, known as Mercer Park Road
Township Road No. 468, known as Crestview Drive
587 ← Township Road No. ~~585~~, known as Eastlake Road
Township Road No. 589, known as Eastlake Road
Township Road No. 635, known as Edgewood Drive
Township Road No. 639, known as 10th Street
Township Road No. 651, known as Colt Road
