ORDINANCE NO. 119

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 117 of 1982 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, which imposes restrictions as to the weight of vehicles and their loads operated on Township roads and provides for the issuance of permits for excessive weight.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: That Section VI of the above-referred-to Ordinance be amended by adding an additional Section VI(a) entitled "Exemption from Ordinance" to be read as follows:

"Section VI(a) - Exemption from Ordinance

This Ordinance shall not apply to vehicles in excess of ten (10) tons that may be utilizing Township roads for the sole purpose of making local deliveries and/or pickups. Provided, however, that all vehicles utilizing Township roads must comply with the weight capacity limits provided by the Vehicle Code and other applicable laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania."

SECTION II: That all Ordinances and amendments hereto executed pertaining to the subject matter of this Ordinance or parts thereto inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: That in all other respects, Ordinance No. 117 of 1982 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.
