AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class; and

WHEREAS, the said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population not greater than 4,999 shall be compensated in an mount not to exceed 1,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the population of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, does not exceed 4,999; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, to set compensation for Supervisors on a monthly basis and within the limitations of Act 68.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED as follows:

- (1) Each Supervisor of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, elected or appointed to office after November 5, 1985, shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the Board of Supervisors the sum of \$1,500.00, per annum.
- (2) Such compensation shall be paid to each supervisor in monthly installments of \$125.00.
- (3) This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the adoption thereof.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into law by Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, this 13th day of February, 1986.
