AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 28 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF APPROPRIATE SIGNS TO GIVE NOTICE THEREOF AND REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES RELATED TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS", BY PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF ADDITIONAL STOP INTERSECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED By the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section Two (2) of Ordinance No. 28 be amended by adding the following as additional stop intersections:

Northwest corner of the intersection of Township Road No. 442 and Township Road No. 663, on Township Road No. 442.

Southeast corner and Northwest corner of the intersection of Township Road No. 442 and Township Road No. 661, on Township Road No. 442.

Southeast corner and Northwest corner of the intersection of Township Road No. 442 and Township Road No. 657, on Township Road No. 442.

Southeast corner of the intersection of Township Road No. 442 and Township Road No. 655, on Township Road No. 442.

Southwest corner of the intersection of Linda Drive, also known as Beacon Woods Drive and Township Road No. 630, on Linda Drive, also known as Beacon Woods Drive.

SECTION 2: All other Ordinances of the Township of Pymatuning not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect, and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the adoption hereof.
