ORDINANCE No. 143

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE OF PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 124, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING GARAGE SALES", BY THE RESTRICTIONS UPON THE ADVERTISEMENT OF GARAGE SALES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: That Article VI(c) of Ordinance No. 124 be amended to read as follows:

(c) No sign or other display advertising the sale shall be placed on a public right-of-way provided, however, that such sign may be placed upon private property other than where the sale is to be conducted if the consent of the owner of such private property is first had and obtained and that such sign shall be promptly removed at the conclusion of the garage sale. No lighted or illuminated signs whatsoever shall be used.

SECTION II: That all Ordinances and amendments thereto pertaining to the subject matter of this Ordinance or parts hereof, that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: In all other respects, Ordinance No. 124 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed, as amended.
