

ORDINANCE NO. 147

An Ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, authorizing the Township of Pymatuning to enter into an agreement with the Borough of Greenville, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to which the Borough of Greenville will provide radio dispatching service for the Township of Pymatuning and will provide for the lodging of prisoners apprehended by police officers of the Township of Pymatuning in the jail of the Borough of Greenville.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: That the Township of Pymatuning enter into a written agreement with the Borough of Greenville which will provide that the Borough of Greenville render police radio dispatching service for the Township of Pymatuning and which will provide for the placement of prisoners apprehended by police officers of the Township of Pymatuning in the jail of the Borough of Greenville, the agreement to be in the form of or substantially in the form of the agreement now on file in the office of the Pymatuning Township Secretary, Municipal Building Edgewood Drive Extension, Transfer, Pennsylvania.

Section 2: That the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning be and he is hereby authorized

and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the Township of Pymatuning.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
