

**ORDINANCE NO. 166 - 1995**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE SUPERVISORS OF PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.**

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 60 of 1995, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class; and

**WHEREAS**, the said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population not greater than 4,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875.00 per annum; and

**WHEREAS**, the population of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, does not exceed 4,999; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly by said Act 60 of 1995 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the Act; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, to set compensation for Supervisors on a monthly basis and within the limitations of Act 60 of 1995.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Each Supervisor of Pymatuning Township, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, elected to office after November 7, 1995, or appointed to or assuming the office of Township Supervisor after the effective date of this Ordinance, shall receive as compensation as Supervisor the sum of \$1,875.00 per annum.

**SECTION 2:** Such compensation shall be paid to each supervisor in monthly or quarterly installments.

**SECTION 3:** The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.
