

PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO: 175-2000

AN ORDINANCE OF PYMATUNING TOWNSHIP, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING AND GRANTING A NONEXCLUSIVE CABLE FRANCHISE TO ADELPHIA COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING.

WHEREAS, the Township of Pymatuning has participated as a member of a Joint Municipal Cable TV Regulatory Advisory Board which has negotiated terms, conditions and provisions for a Nonexclusive Cable TV Franchise Agreement within Pymatuning Township; and,

WHEREAS, the said Advisory Board has recommended to the Board of Supervisors that the attached Cable Television Franchise Agreement be accepted and approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, ordains as follows:

- Section 1. The Township of Pymatuning grants to Adelphia Communications Corporation a Nonexclusive Cable Television Franchise providing for the installation, operation and maintenance of cable television and other telecommunications systems within the Township's boundaries and to provide services and benefits for its residents, with the Cable Television Franchise Agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law and after acceptance of the Cable Television Franchise Agreement by Adelphia Communications Corporation and, after acceptance through appropriate passage and publication by the participating municipalities comprising the Joint Municipal Cable TV Regulatory Advisory Board.
- Section 3. The Pymatuning Township Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the attached Cable Television Franchise Agreement.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances insofar as they are inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of this Governing Body that the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately in accordance with the provisions of law.
