

Ordinance No. 190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 188 TO INCREASE THE LOCAL SERVICES TAX RATE FROM \$30.00 PER ANNUM TO \$40.00 PER ANNUM..

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Article 4. of Ordinance No. 188 of Pymatuning Township shall be amended to modify the tax levied therein from \$30 per annum to \$40 per annum beginning January 1, 2009 and continuing on a calendar basis annually thereafter, until modified or repealed by a subsequent ordinance. This tax shall remain to be in addition to all other taxes of any kind or nature heretofore levied by the municipality.

Section 2. The other provisions of Ordinance No. 188, and all other ordinances or portions thereof not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
