## Ordinance No. 192

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 190 TO INCREASE THE LOCAL SERVICES TAX RATE FROM \$40.00 PER ANNUM TO \$52.00 PER ANNUM..

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED as follows:

Section 1. Article 4. of Ordinance No. 190 of Pymatuning Township shall be amended to modify the tax levied therein from \$40 per annum to \$52 per annum beginning January 1, 2010 and continuing on a calendar basis annually thereafter, until modified or repealed by a subsequent ordinance. This tax shall remain to be in addition to all other taxes of any kind or nature heretofore levied by the municipality.

- Section 2. The other provisions of Ordinance No. 190, and all other ordinances or portions thereof not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.
  - Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
