## ORDINANCE NO. 30

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 28 entitled "An Ordinance providing for the establishment of certain traffic regulations in the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, providing for the installation of appropriate signs to give notice thereof and repealing prior Ordinances relating to traffic regulations" and designating six-ton weight limits on Township Roads 420, 422, 428, 466, 585, 587 and 589.

Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, and it si hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

> That Section (4) be and is hereby amended to read as follows: SECTION 4.

> A weight limit as hereafter prescribed for motor vehicles is hereby established on the following roads of Pymatuning Township:

- (a) Township Road No. 420 six tons
- (b) Township Road No. 422 six tons
- (e) Township Road No. 428 six tons
- (d) Township Road No. 400 six tons
- (e) Township Road No. 466 six tons
- (f) Township Road No. 585 six tons
- (g) Township Road No. 587 six tons
- (h) Township Road No. 589 six tons

## き性TION 2.

SECTION 1.

The proper officials of the Township are hereby directed to erect traffic signs to give notice of the regulations designated in Section (1) hereof.

## SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
