

ORDINANCE NO. 108

An Ordinance of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, amending the Pymatuning Township Zoning Ordinance by changing the zoning classification of land located at the northwest corner of the intersection of 10th Street and Arlington Drive to "R-4" Residential Multiple-Family.

Be it Enacted and Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1: That the Pymatuning Township Zoning Ordinance be and is hereby amended to change the zoning classification to "R-4" Residential-Multiple Family of the following described land situate in the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania:

Commencing at a point at the intersection of the centerlines of 10th Street and Arlington Drive, thence northwesterly along the centerline of Arlington Drive a distance of 940 feet to a point; thence in a southwesterly direction along the northern property line of land owned by Forest Investment Corporation a distance of 535 feet to a point; thence southeasterly along the west property line of Forest Investment Corporation and land of Reynolds Mobile Home Park, a distance of 697 feet to a point at the intersection of this line with the existing R-4 boundary (which extends north from the centerline of 10th Street a distance of 245 feet); thence in a northeasterly direction along said R-4 boundary a distance of 240 feet to a point, which is the eastern limits of the R-4 District on the north side of 10th Street; thence in a southeasterly direction along said R-4 boundary a distance of 245 feet to a point where this line intersects with the centerline of 10th Street; thence in a northeastwardly direction a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2: That the Pymatuning Township Zoning Map be amended to

show this change in the zoning classification of the
above-described land.
