

ORDINANCE NO. 100

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 52 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, known as the Pennsylvania Township Zoning Ordinance by amending the text in regard to the zoning district known as the Flood Plain District, regarding utilization of appropriate construction practices to minimize flood damage and regulate development in areas subject to flooding within the township.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: That Subsection A905.4 (2) of the Pymatuning Township Zoning Ordinance be amended by deleting any reference to Flood Fringe Area and General Flood Plain Area and adding the following:

"A905.4(2) Within any identified Flood Prone Area(s) any structure of the kind described in Section I, above shall be:"

SECTION II: That all Ordinances and amendments hereto executed pertaining to the subject matter of this Ordinance or parts thereto inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: That in all other respects, Ordinance No. 52 of 1966 of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.
