ORDINANCE NO. 158 - 1993

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PYMATUNING, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RENAMING MERCER PARK ROAD BETWEEN RUTLEDGE ROAD AND EAST LAKE ROAD TO CRESTVIEW DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, has previously named that portion of roadway from the intersection of Rutledge Drive, Southwardly to East Lake Road, Mercer Park Road; and

WHEREAS, in order to assist in effectuation of the Mercer County, Pennsylvania Enhanced 9-1-1 System, it has been deemed advisable to rename Mercer Park Road to Crestview Drive; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is authorized by the Act of May 1, 1993, P.L. 103, Art. VII, Section 702, cl. XXXVII, as amended (53 P.S. §65737).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pymatuning, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> The street known as Mercer Park Road, and also designated as Township Road No. 466, in Pymatuning Township, beginning at the intersection of Rutledge Road, travelling in a Southerly direction for approximately one (1) mile, and terminating at the intersection of East Lake Road, is hereby renamed Crestview Drive.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such finding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Pymatuning Township Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption as required by law.
